JCEP Meeting Responsibilities: Chairing organization arranges transportation for delegates to attend the Joint Council of Extension Professionals (JCEP) meeting.

Policy & Leadership Development Conference (PILD) Washington DC Responsibilities: The chair will contact the Extension Director's Office to schedule a meeting to discuss the professional development opportunity of PILD. The contact should be made in January before the April meeting.

Conference with Administration Responsibilities: Collect resolutions from each organization, combine and eliminate duplications and those that should be addressed directly with someone in the administration other than the director. Coordinate schedules of Extension director, President, President Elect and Secretary of organizations to schedule meeting date, time, place with Extension Director. The meeting to discuss resolutions will be the first Monday in May.

State Galaxy Conference Responsibilities: Chair Galaxy conference planning committee and treasure of responsible organization serves as treasurer for Galaxy conference. See separate Galaxy handbook for details.

Legislative Event: The Legislative Event will not be conducted unless requested by the Vice President for Agriculture.
