



PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURES	Introduce a business item	"I move that"	
	Withdraw a business item	"I withdraw my motion."	
	Change a business item	"I move to amend the motion by (adding, striking out, inserting) the words"	
	Stop the discussion and vote	"I move the previous question."	
	Postpone a business item	"I move to postpone this matter until(provide a date/time)"	
	Limit or extend the discussion "I move to limit discussion to (time or number of speakers)."/"I move to extend discussion"		
	Refer item to committee	"I move to refer this matter to committee." (either specify a committee or a new one to be selected)	
	To kill a motion without voting "I move to postpone indefinitely."		
	Move on to an urgent item	"I move to lay all pending matters on the table in consideration of a more important topic"	
	To bring back an item that's	"I move to reconsider the vote on the motion."	
	already been voted on	(must have voted on the winning side)	
	Request a break	"I move that we recess for"	
	Request more information	"Point of information." (state question)	
	Complain about heat, noise, etc "I rise to a question of privilege." (state issue)
