4-H Youth Leadership Disc Golf

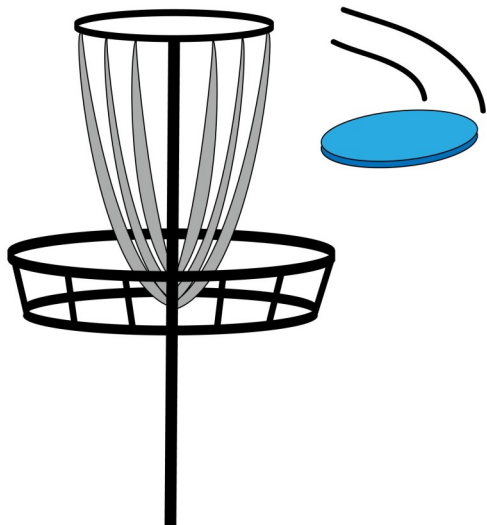
Baxter Co Youth Leadership Club members!
