

Crittenden County Master Gardener Scholarship

Description: This scholarship is to assist a Crittenden County, Arkansas resident in pursuing a four-year degree in agriculture or agriculture related fields, including but not limited to horticulture, botany, agronomy, forestry, plant science, landscape, architecture/design, and turf management. Applicants must have a minimal 2.5 grade point average.

Scholarships are awarded based on the funds raised by the Crittenden County Master Gardeners. Total dollar amount awarded will vary from year to year depending upon funds raised by the Crittenden County Master Gardeners and the number of eligible applicants. Priority will be given to current recipients.

2. Attach a copy of your high school transcript, ACT (or equivalent) scores, and a copy of your college transcript (if at least one semester has been completed).
3. Attach essay from the Career Goals section
