### 4-H Poultry Chain



Sign-up for the 2021 4-H Poultry Chain is now underway. 4-H'ers of all ages are eligible to participate in this project. Participants will receive **up** to 20, depends on supply, one day-old chicks free of charge. The brown egg layer, Hyline Brown, is the breed being offered this year. **Deadline to** register is Monday, March 1st. In return the participant must furnish a

secure, clean, warm place for the chicks to grow and must agree to return four of the pullets to the Fulton County Fair for show and sale. The pullets will be auctioned off to continue funding the 4-H Poultry Chain program. (If we do not have a fair, we will make similar arrangements as we did in 2020) Call the Extension Office to sign up for your child's chicks. Remember, if you want a rooster, please let us know. Also, you must be enrolled in 4-H for chicks to be ordered for you.

### <u>4-H Poster Art Contest</u>

2020 Theme: 4-H's Got Talent! or open 4-H theme. 4-H members ages 9-19. Posters should be 14" x 22" in dimension and may be horizontal or vertical. Posters may be any medium art - watercolor, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils or collage. They cannot contain any copyrighted material such as cartoon characters and cannot have any three dimensional items on them. One poster entry per 4-H member will be accepted. The 4-H member's name, age, county, full address and brief interpretation of art work must be attached. Posters should be submitted to me at jfoster Duada.edu by April 23rd.

### Amazeum 4-H STEAM Zingo

You've heard of bingo, but ZINGO has an Amazeum twist! Just like regular bingo, you need to complete five challenges in a row, column, or diagonal. But this is where it gets Amazeum-ified! We've come up with fun, community-based challenges for you to complete with your club virtually, in the community, and at the Amazeum. Each square on your Zingo card is an activity, game or adventure. Zingo is self-paced and you have the whole month of May to complete it. You'll earn a special Amazeum pin once you complete a Zingo!

Zingo is a great way to gain educational experiences for your record books this year!

\$10 program fee includes: digital Zingo card, one Amazeum pin, admission for one 4-H member and one adult to the Amazeum during regular museum hours during the month of May.

Ready to Zingo?

Step 1: Register to participate by clicking here. A few days after you register, you will receive a confirmation email with your Zingo card.

Step 2: Print off your Zingo card and create a plan with your club or caregiver. What pathway do you want to explore to earn your Amazeum pin?

Step 3: Start Zingo-ing! Check off your Zingo card as you complete an activity square.

Step 4: Is your Zingo almost complete? Now it is time to plan your visit to the Amazeum. Use the admission code in your confirmation letter to visit the Amazeum during May.

Step 5: Explore exhibits, Pop-Ups, and Tinkering Hub to complete your Zingo card at the Amazeum.

Step 6: Show your Zingo card at the Admission desk to earn your Amazeum pin.

Step 7: Celebrate your accomplishment and show off your new Amazeum pin at your next club meeting!




The Ross Foundation 4-H Photography Contest provides an opportunity for Arkansas 4-H'ers to demonstrate, compete, and exhibit their photography skills. All 4-H members ages 9-19 are eligible and may enter a unique, original photo into each category. There will be a COUNTY LEVEL contest first. At the county level, each 4-H member may enter two color photographs (one must be in the living category, if two are entered) and two black-and-white photographs (one must be in the living category and one must be in the living category and one must be in the living category. Four county winners are selected, one in each category – these will be submitted to the state level.

At the state level, each county may enter four photographs. These must be the same winners in the four categories at county level. First, second and third-place winners are selected in each category.

Digital cameras should be set at the highest resolution. The photo may be enhanced to improve quality, and you may change a color image into black and white. Plant life (flowers, trees, bushes) are considered non-living for this contest.
