FULTON COUNTY FAIR ONLINE ENTRIES ARE NOW OPEN

Go to our website at www.fultoncountyfair.org and follow the link on the home page or on the links to the Creative Arts or Livestock Tabloids. All livestock entries including Horses, Poultry and Rabbits must be made online by **July 15**, **2017**. Creative Arts entries can be made online or with a paper entry form and are due **July 15**, **2017**.

IMPORTANT FAIR HEALTH REGULATIONS & HEALTH PAPERS

Health papers (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) are required for swine and all cattle, except for market steers, and they must be issued within 90 days of exhibition. This is the responsibility of the exhibitor. If a health paper day does not work out or if you can't make it the scheduled day, you'll need to seek out a veterinarian and schedule a time to have papers written.

<u>Sheep and goats</u> must have a scrapies ID (If you don't already have these, they can be ordered from the USDA by calling 1-866-873-2824 to order tags for your specific flock and farm.). DO NOT leave the farm until that animal has a scrapie tag in its ear.

It is a federal law that sheep and goats have scrapie tags for inter- and intrastate movement. If you don't already have these, they can be ordered from the USDA by calling 1-866-873-2824 to order tags for your specific flock and farm.

Swine must have an official USDA tag (840) or premise identification tag. In the past, I gave these out from the Extension Office. I can no longer do that. If a hog doesn't have a tag in its ear when the exhibitor is at a breeder's farm, simply have the exhibitor ask the breeder if they have either an 840 or premise ID tag as it is a State of Arkansas Livestock Exhibition requirement. If the breeder does not have either one, the exhibitor can call the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission (501-907-2400) and provide the following information:

- •Exhibitor Name, Address, Phone Number, and County
- Breed and sex of hog
- •Previous Owner Name, Address, and Phone Number

In order for swine to get a health paper written, there must be an accompanying negative pseudorabies and brucellosis test that has been done within 90 days of exhibition.

You must allow enough time (\sim 2 weeks) to get the results back from the blood test. If you wait until a week before the fair to have blood drawn and then expect to get the results back and have health papers issued, you may be out of luck!

<u>Cattle – Heifers</u> that will be exhibited between 4-12 months of age must be brucellosis vaccinated.

No livestock will be admitted if they're showing any signs of disease Any and all other regulations of the Fulton County Fair Association and Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission will apply as well. Familiarize yourself with them!

<u>Poultry and Rabbit Showmanship</u> There will be poultry and rabbits showmanship divisions this year. Junior divisions will be exhibitors ages 9-13, and seniors will be exhibitors ages 14-19. Youth exhibitor must be present during judging to be eligible. If not present, that particular exhibit will not be included in the showmanship judging.

Poultry and rabbit showmanship will be judge on criteria ranging from appearance and attitude of the exhibitor, appearance of the bird, showmanship (how it is removed from the cage, presented to the judge, and handled), and knowledge of the breed and your project management. If you want some more information about poultry and rabbit showmanship, let me know, and I can mail you some information!

SELLING POULTRY CHAIN DIFFERENTLY AND NEED YOUR HELP



We are trying a new way of selling 4-H Poultry Chain chicks at the fair. Instead of selling them at the auction on Saturday, buyers will have the opportunity to purchase individual pens immediately after judging on Thursday and Friday. So, if you have someone interested in buying your birds, they will be able to select the pens they want and pay any time after judging. The birds can be picked up Saturday morning from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. **The only exception to this will be the Grand & Reserve Champion pens, which will still sell at the premium auction on Saturday. Those exhibitors are encouraged and expected to be at the auction.**

Blue ribbon pens (4 birds) will cost \$35 per pen. Red ribbon pens (4 birds) will cost \$25 per pen. White ribbon pens (4 birds) will cost \$20 per pen. Checks can be written to the Fulton County Fair.

We are making this change to help shorten the premium auction and to ensure a set amount of money return to the program to pay for birds the following year.
