Due to COVID-19 we are unable to have a Poultry Chain Sale at the JR Livestock Auction, but we have good news! Buyers have called the office and are VERY interested in buying your chickens. Ms. Jamie will be calling 4-H Families the 2nd week of July and she will be giving you a name and number of the buyer interested. You can set up a time and place to meet with your buyer to sell your chickens. It was advertised on Facebook each pen would sell for \$35 each. **Families are still asked to pay the Fulton County Extension Office the \$25 for every set you received by July 31st.** You can mail your check to us at PO Box 308, Salem, AR 72576 or drop off at the Fulton County Extension Office. Fulton County Livestock Show Schedule

The traditional Fulton County Fair is cancelled and the shows will be Jackpot Shows for Fulton County Youth Only and are not sponsored by the Fulton County Fair.

Tentative schedule pending approval by the Arkansas Health Department and Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission.

July 10 - Deadline for all entries must be made online and entry fees paid. Online entry link to be published soon.

July 23 - Beef and Dairy Cattle check-in from 7:00 to 9:00 a.m. Dairy Show starts at 12:00 p.m. with Beef Cattle will follow. All animals are dismissed as soon as they are shown. Exhibitors who have cattle to sell at the Junior Livestock Auction will bring the cattle back for the sale on Saturday

July 25 – Sheep and Goats and Swine check-in from 7:00 to 9:00 a.m. Shows to follow at 12:00 p.m. All animals are dismissed as soon as they show unless they will sell at the Junior Livestock Sale.

July 25 – *Junior Livestock Auction for Cattle, Hogs, Sheep and Goats at 4:00 p.m.

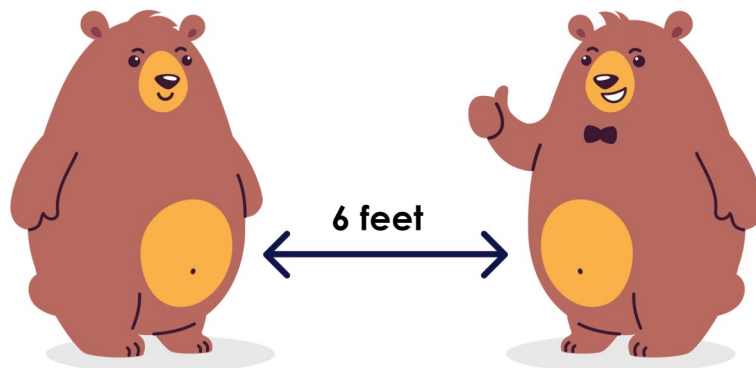
Poultry and Rabbits are not included in the Jackpot Show and Sale.

***Only exhibitors who reside in Fulton County or are enrolled in a Fulton County 4-H Club or a Fulton County FFA Chapter.**

*All Arkansas Health Department and CDC guidelines must be observed for the shows and sale. Exhibitors will be scheduled for the wash racks to practice social distancing. **Because of planning the layout in the barns for social distancing, entries that are not pre-registered will not be accepted.***
