October is 4-H promotion month & National 4-H Week is October 4-10, 2020. The theme is "Opportunity4All". As leaders in youth development, this week is a great opportunity to celebrate and promote 4-H in your county.

National 4-H Council has resources to help you promote National 4-H Week. The 2020 National 4-H Week Promotional Toolkit contains a wide variety of media relations and marketing tools to help you successfully promote National 4-H Week events and activities in your community.

The <u>National 4-H Week toolkit</u> is now available with resources in both English and Spanish. To access the promotional resources, you must set up an account.

Suggested Activities

October 1-31- One Day of Service = A Month of Service (A.M.O.S) A.M.O.S enables each 4-H member to recruit friends to help make their communities better through adopting a service project. One Day of Service" will be <u>any day</u> in October that you and your 4-H'ers choose! 4-H Promotion month is in October so what a perfect way to promote 4-H - by serving others. These projects can be done as individuals or as an entire county 4-H program. **** Due to Covid-19, please adhere to the COVID-19 restrictions and guidelines. *****

October 4- Healthy Living Sunday! Get ready for the week ahead by taking a moment to do something that makes you a little healthier! Share a picture or video of you doing some jumping jacks, fixing a healthy snack, or even going through a 4-H Yoga Flow. When you post on social media make sure you use the hashtag #ARAH and tag Darkansas4h in your posts!

October 5-Media Monday! Let's share all about Arkansas 4-H through many media outlets! Provide the local newspaper with articles written by members, volunteers, alumni and donors; do a PSA about 4-H at your local radio station; or share a post/picture/video on social media that tells all about your 4-H experiences!

October 6 – 4-H Pets Day! Do you have a pet (alive or stuffed animal!) that you want to show off? Maybe they even have a 4-H Clover handkerchief, collar, or toy?? Post a picture or video of your pet & tell us all about them!

Remember to use the hashtag #ARAH and tag DarkansasAh in the post!

October 7- 4-H Spirit Day!!! (Show your 4-H pride & wear the Clover) Advertise a wear green day, emphasizing the 4-H Clover! Have a 4-H mask? Be sure to wear it! Use social media to announce the event and post photos. Encourage 4-Hers, volunteer leaders, and anyone involved in your 4-H program to post a picture or video on social media showing off their 4-H Spirit; make sure they use the hashtag #ARAH and tag DarkansasAh in the post!

October 8- Be a good Citizen Thursday! Host an "appreciation day" for police officers, the fire department, elected officials, city/county employees, teachers, or others. This year, especially, it's important to recognize the essential workers that have continued to help our communities thrive during the COVID-19 pandemic. Write letters or draw pictures for those essential works, make a donation, or post on social media, tagging the group if you can, thanking them for serving your community well.

October 9-Donor & Supporter's Recognition Day!!! Have 4-H'ers write thank you notes; mail them pictures or post pictures on social media of the past year's 4-H highlights. Tell them *Thanks for being a friend to 4-H*. If you post on social media, make sure that you tag your donors & supporter; then use the hashtag #AR4H and tag Darkansas4h as well!

October 10- Local Restaurant Day!!!! Select 2 to 3 restaurants in your county and place 4-H promotional place mats in the restaurants.

Tips for Hosting a Virtual 4-H Club Meeting

Zoom is a popular option. With a free account it can be used for meetings 40 minutes or less. Volunteers can sign up for the free Version here: https://zoom.us/.

It is important to follow 4-H policies and guidelines to keep everyone safe during a virtual club meeting. Always be the last to leave the meeting. This will ensure all youth have signed out of the meeting. Be flexible and understanding. If youth aren't able to participate, there shouldn't be any penalty. Virtual 4-H club meetings cannot be mandatory and cannot count against club attendance. If your club member cannot attend due to limited internet capabilities, you can still reach out to the members with updates and projects you are working on.
