#### <u>COVID-19</u>

#### When to Clean and When to Disinfect

Cleaning with products containing soap or detergent reduces germs on surfaces by removing contaminants and decreases risk of infection from surfaces. When no people with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 are known to have been in a space, <u>cleaning once a day is usually enough</u> to sufficiently remove virus that may be on surfaces and help maintain a healthy facility. Disinfecting (using <u>U.S.</u> <u>Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)'s List N disinfectants</u>external icon) kills any remaining germs on surfaces, which further reduces any risk of spreading infection. You may want to either clean more frequently or choose to disinfect (in addition to cleaning) in shared spaces if the space is a high traffic area or if certain conditions apply that can increase the risk of infection from touching surfaces: <u>High</u> <u>transmission</u> of COVID-19 in your community; Low vaccination rates in your community; Infrequent use of other prevention measures, such as mask wearing (among unvaccinated people) and hand hygiene; or The space is occupied by people at <u>increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19</u> If there has been a sick person or someone who tested positive for COVID-19 in your facility within the last 24 hours, you should clean AND disinfect the space.
