The conference will be held at the Four States Fair Entertainment Center in Texarkana, AR. Programs will begin at 8:30 AM and conclude around 3:15 PM. Activities include Extension programs with speaker presentations. There will be three breaks during the day, plus lunch, during which time participants can visit with exhibitors.
