

### ARKANSAS 4-H FOOD CHALLENGE NEED TEAM MEMBERS FOR SALINE COUNTY

The Arkansas 4-H Food Challenge is a brand new competition in Arkansas 4-H, that gives youth the opportunity to showcase their culinary knowledge and skills when preparing and presenting a dish. The competition provides opportunities to experience teamwork, public speaking, food safety, financial literacy, and cooking.

The competition is scheduled for August 6th, and county youth will participate in teams of 3-4 (Junior Division and Senior Division.)

Each team will be provided with a mystery "main ingredient" on the



day of the contest, and they'll have 40 minutes to prepare a dish using their main ingredient and other items in the competition pantry. Teams will also calculate the price of their dish and the number of servings based on the ingredients used. They will then plate and serve their dish to judges, and give a presentation about their dish.

Saline County is currently recruiting for its Senior Team (ages 14-19). Spots are limited and will be "first come, first serve." After teams are formed, we will plan team practice sessions to prepare for the competition. 

Arkansas 4-H is sharing a wonderful opportunity for 4-H volunteers statewide. Every year, National 4-H Congress recognizes the accomplishments of youth in the 4-H program and provides an outstanding educational opportunity for 4-H youth development. Youth attending the conference return home with new ideas and a commitment to become more involved in their communities.

This year's 4-H Congress is going to be held on November 26-30, 2021 in Atlanta Georgia. More than 1,000 4-H members, volunteers, agents and state staff from across the United States attend the conference annually.
