Due to COVID-19 disruption, the Arkansas State 4-H Office has changed the format of the 2020 District O-Rama to a Virtual Project Showcase. Our Saline County 4-H O-Rama will follow the same format, and it will give 4-H members a chance to practice their recording and speaking skills before submitting their District O-Rama showcase. State O-Rama will be open to ALL SENIORS and the format is still to be determined. Details about State O-Rama will follow as we learn more.

## **DISTRICT 4-H O-RAMA** VIRTUAL PROJECT SHOWCASE

Submission Deadline: June 22, 2020

open to all JUNIOR 4-H members. The purpose is to give 4-H members the opportunity to showcase their project work. 4-H members will upload a video to tell others about their project work.

### **Showcase Guidelines**

Who Can Participate: Open to all JUNIOR (9-13) 4-H members. All participants must be enrolled in the online 4-H Enrollment and Event System.

**Showcase Participants:** Each video showcase can feature up to two (2) 4-H youth. A 4-H youth can also participate in more than one showcase. (Siblings can help each other out!) County programs can have unlimited videos per project area, and illustrated talks and demonstrations can also be used as a showcase.

Format: The showcase must be a video presentation. Each participant must include their name, county, and project. Each video must be 2-5 minutes, and they can be recorded with any standard platform. Your county agent is here to assist you with uploading your videos and any recording questions!

Submission Date: All videos must be submitted to your county agent (mmaulden@uaex.edu) or uploaded to Flipgrid by June 22nd. Flip code is "orama" and the password is "Saline4H". The flip code and password are both case sensitive.

Awards: All participants will receive a participation certificate. The top three (3) videos in each mandate area will be highlighted by the State 4-H Office.

Fee: This event is FREE to all Junior 4-H members.

## **COUNTY 4-H O-RAMA VIRTUAL PROJECT SHOWCASE**

Submission Deadline: June 12, 2020

The District 4-H O-Rama Virtual Project Showcase is The County 4-H O-Rama will be modeled after the District O-Rama Project Showcase, and is open to 4-H members of ALL AGES. The purpose is to give 4-H members the opportunity to showcase their project work and prepare for District O-Rama.

### **Showcase Guidelines**

Who Can Participate: Open to 4-H members of ALL AGES. All participants must be enrolled in the online 4-H Enrollment and Event System.

**Showcase Participants:** Each video showcase can feature up to two (2) 4-H youth. A 4-H youth can also participate in more than one showcase. (Siblings can help each other out!)

Format: The showcase must be a video presentation. Each participant must include their name, county, and project. Each video must be 2-5 minutes, and they can be recorded with any standard platform. Your county agent is here to assist you with uploading your videos and any recording questions!

**Submission Date:** All videos must be submitted to your county agent (mmaulden@uaex.edu) or uploaded to Flipgrid by June 12th. Flip code is "orama" and the password is "Saline4H". The flip code and password are both case sensitive.

**Awards:** All participants will receive a participation certificate and will be featured on the Saline County 4-H Facebook page. Judges will provide constructive feedback.

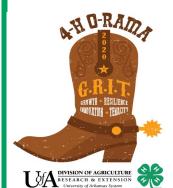

## How To Use Flipgrid

## **Steps for Submitting Video**

- Download Flipgrid app on phone or visit https:// flipgrid.com/orama on your computer
- When prompted, enter flip code "orama" and password "Saline4H"
- Record a video directly into the app, or upload an existing video
- Choose a selfie to post with your video
- Enter your information, including: 4-Her Name, County, Project Area, and Showcase Title



\*Note that videos will not show up until they have been approved by our Flipgrid admin.

### **Recording on Computer**

- 1. Start a Zoom session with yourself, and click the "Record Session" option. You can also "share screen" and record your screen via Zoom.
- 2. Record through Chrome Browser
  - A Download Screencastify Extension
  - **B. Download Loom Extension**
- 3. Download Loom Desktop Application

## **Recording on Mobile Devices**

- 1. Record from your device through your device camera
- 2. Record directly into the Flipgrid app. The app is available through the App Store on all smartphones and tablets.

\*Note if you have low internet bandwidth, it is recommended that you record from your device camera or computer before uploading (rather than recording directly into Flipgrid.)
