

### Acronyms and Definitions

- HAP: Hazardous Air Pollutants, 33 chemicals are currently listed
- CI: Compression Ignition (diesel)
- SI: Spark Ignition (e.g. natural gas, propane, gasoline)
- 2 Stroke (2S): Power cycle completed in one revolution of crankshaft
- 4 Stroke (4S): Power cycle completed in two revolutions of crankshaft
- Lean Burn (LB): higher air/fuel ratio (fuel lean)
- Rich Burn (RB): Lower air/fuel ratio (fuel rich)
- CO: Carbon Monoxide
- CH<sub>2</sub>O: Formaldehyde
