



2022 Arkansas Cotton Research Verification Program Weekly Update – September 30, 2022

General Information

Defoliation and harvest are in full swing in the state as we keep moving through this season. We harvested our 2 earliest planted plots last week in Lee County and are waiting on more to pick. These cooler temperatures are slowing if not halting any more maturation of bolls. We need to be getting our defoliations applications out soon before it gets even colder and we lose even more plant activity making it an even harder task. Some fields may not make it to our 850 DD60 target however, we need to look and judge based on our target harvest completion date of Nov. 1 to make sure we are not going to be waiting on our pickers and running later into the year.

The Extension service has a useful tool for finding out how may heat units have been accumulated with our DD60 calculator. It is very fast and easy to use. This resource can be found at https://growdegreecalc.uada.edu/
