5	Idea. Symmetrical	Ideal. Approximately 45-degree angle from hoof to pastern joint to leg with good toe length and heel depth
6	Slight claw curl	Slightly shallow heel and long toe
7	Slight claw curl with one claw becoming noticeable greater than the other	Moderately shallow heel and long toe with somewhat weak pasterns
8	Moderate scissor/screw appearance: moderately unsound	Shallow heel and long toe: marginally unsound
9	Extreme scissor or screw claw with excessive curling: unsound	Extremely shallow heel and long toe with extremely weak pasterns: unsound
