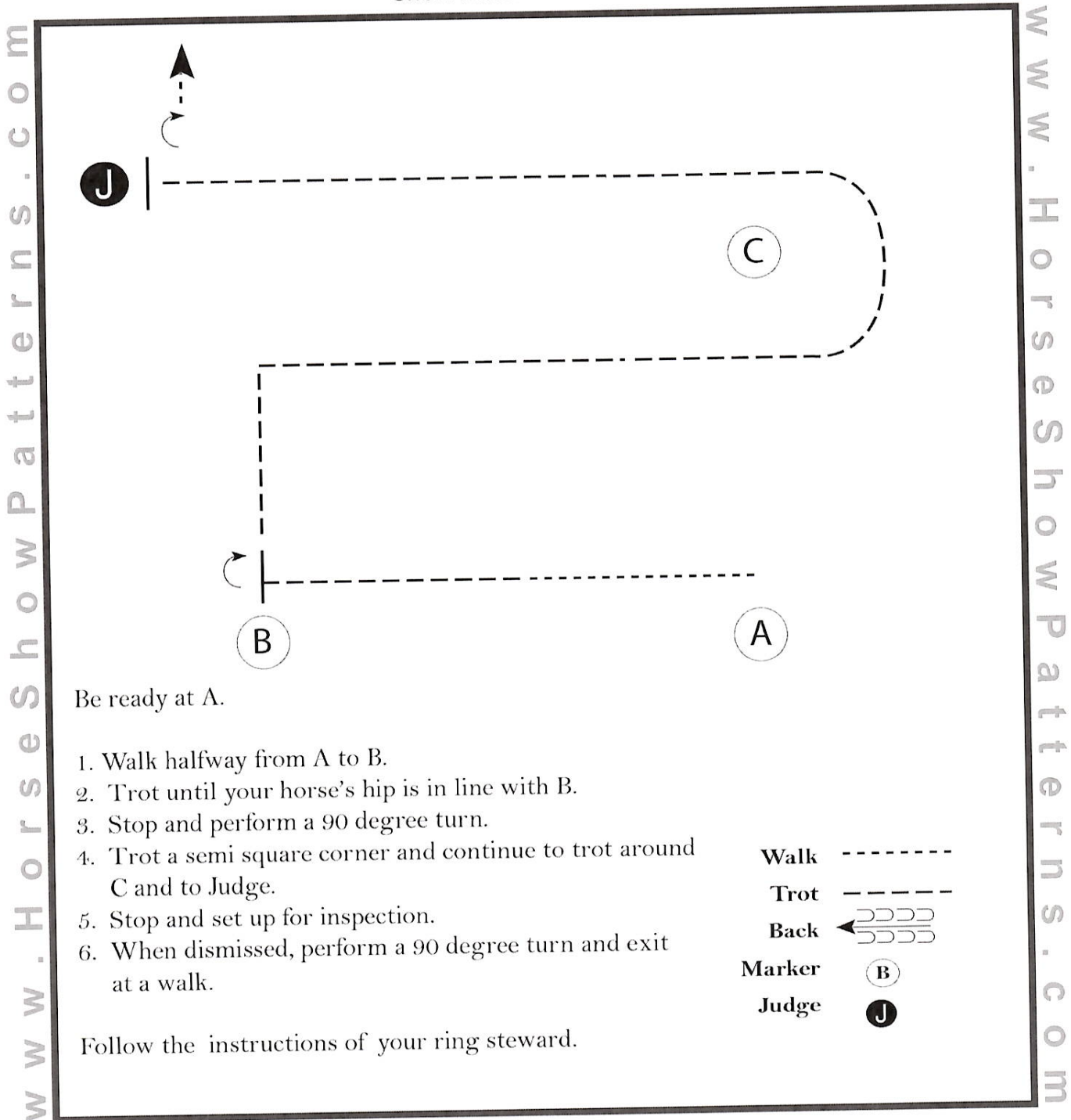

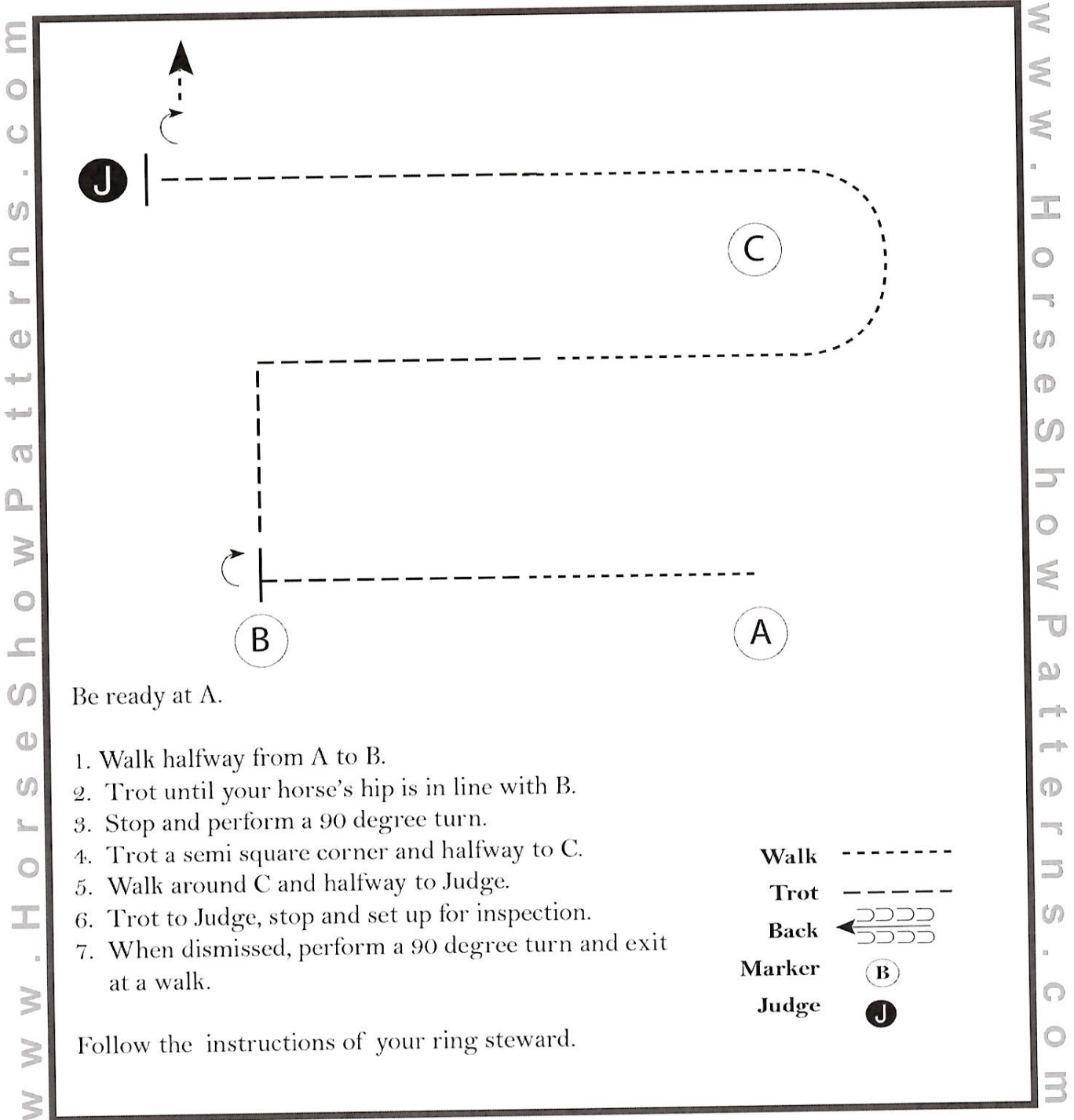

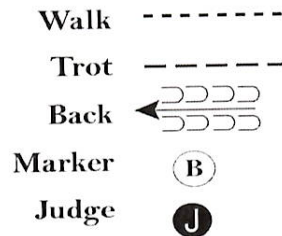

Be ready at A.

1. Walk halfway from A to B.
2. Trot until your horse's hip is in line with B.
3. Stop and perform a 90 degree turn.
4. Trot a semi square corner and halfway to C.
5. Walk around C and halfway to Judge.
6. Trot to Judge, stop and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn and exit at a walk.



Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

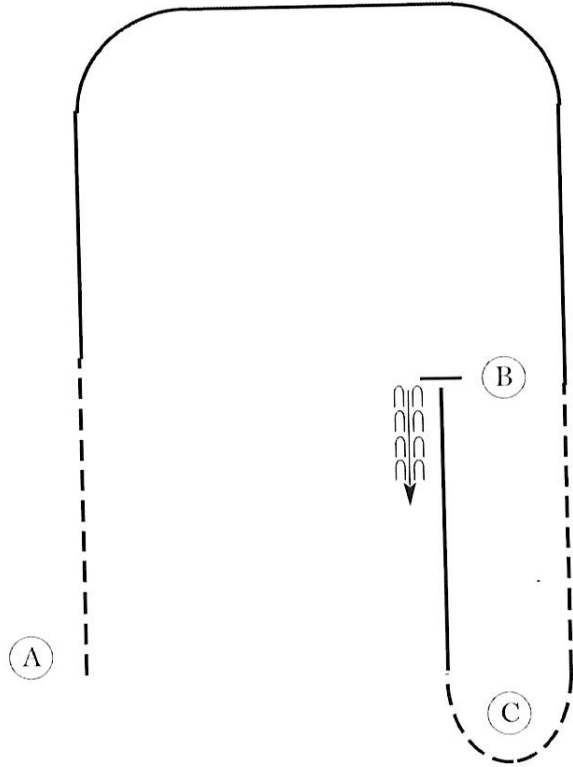

5. Stop and back.

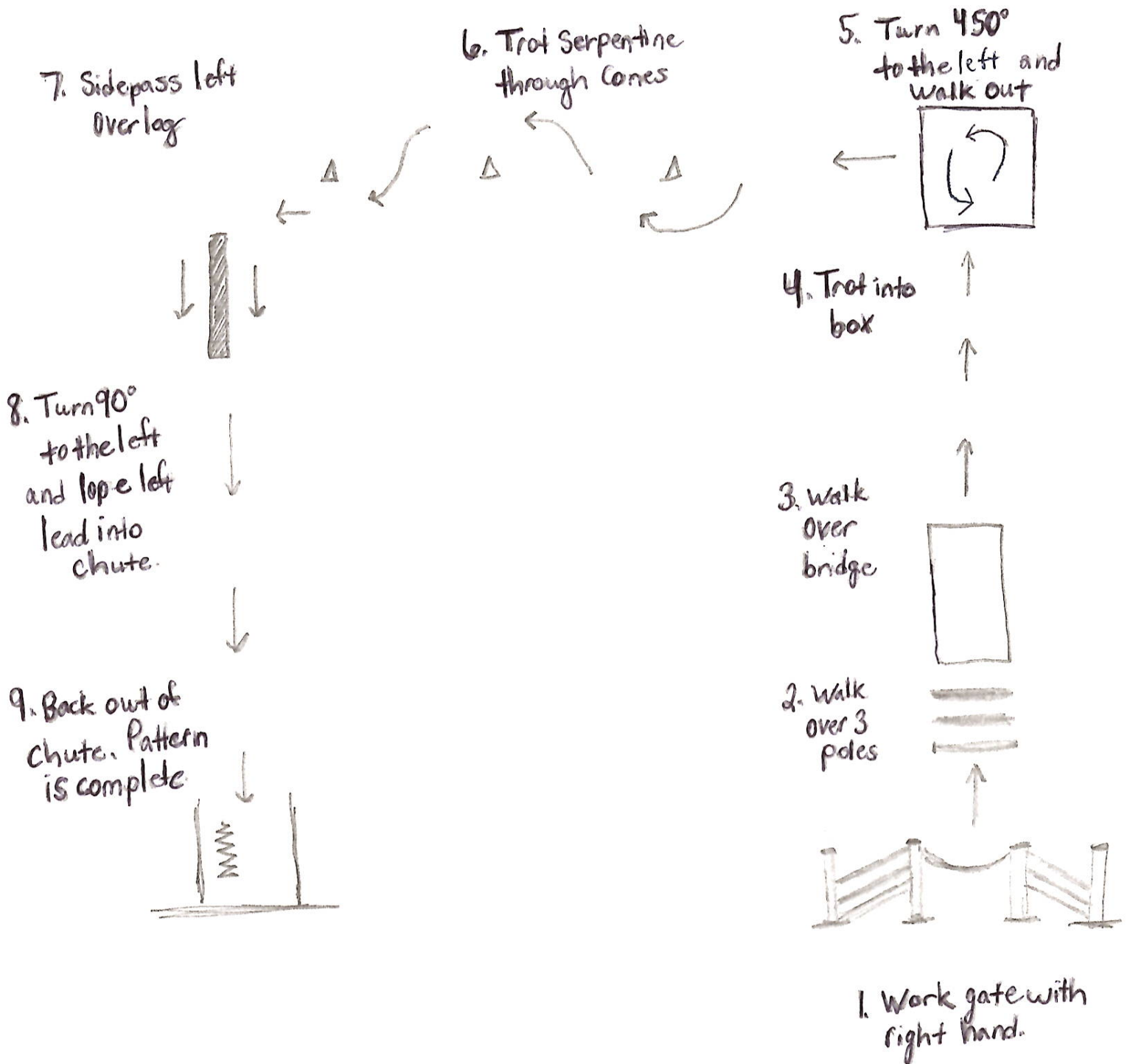

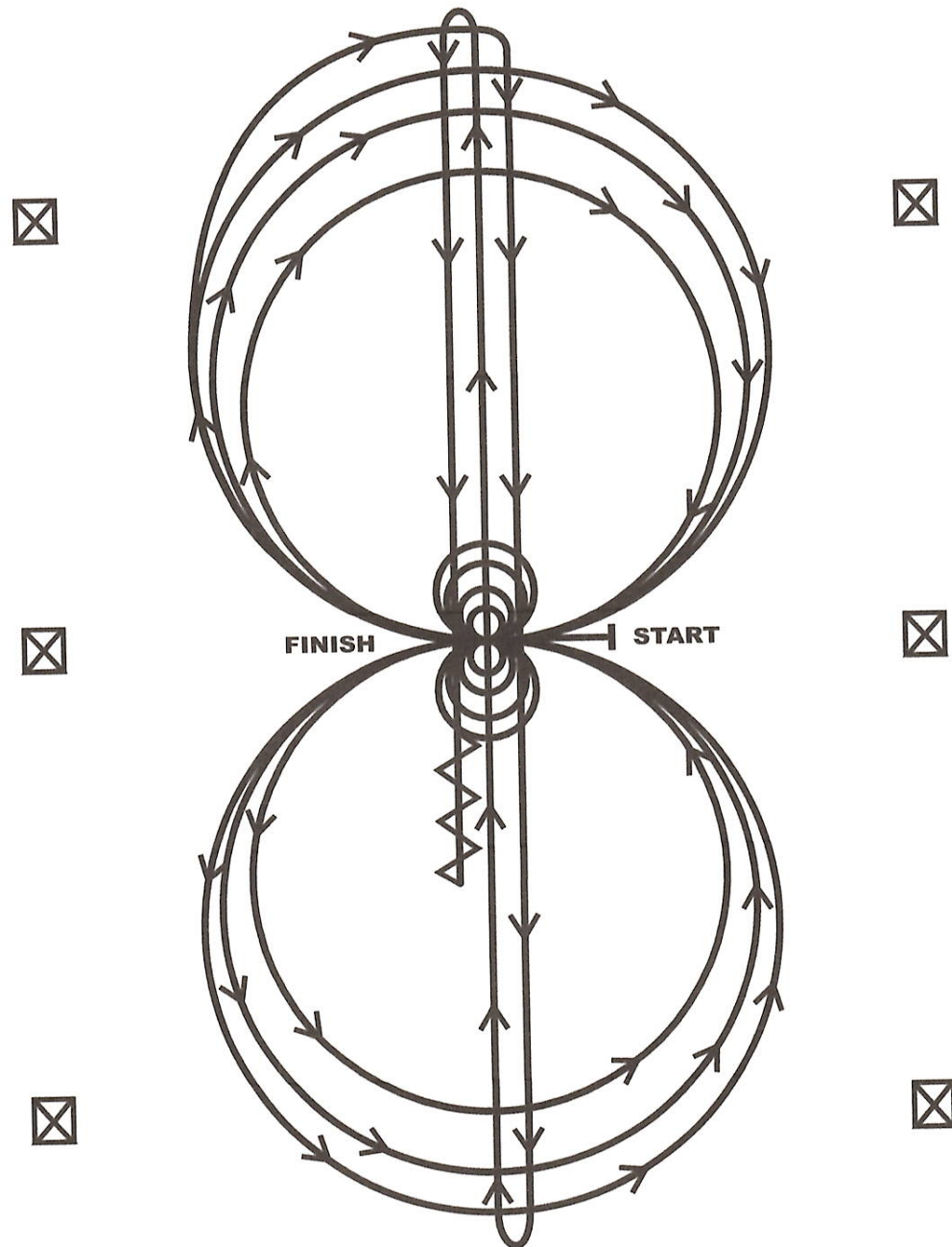

1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Trot over logs, stop
4. Side pass right over log
5. 1 1/2 turn right
6. Extended lope right lead
7. Lope right lead
8. Extended trot
9. Lope left lead
10. Walk
11. Trot
12. Stop and back

This Pattern is a combination of the pattern only and should be performed in a sequence of the pattern. The rider should be able to perform the pattern in a sequence of the pattern.

REINING PATTERN 2



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.
