Jefferson county received the most rain with 3.26" and Poinsett County received the least amount of rain with .6". Herbicide applications continue to be a challenge with rain delays. Woodruff County has started to see an increase in green stinkbugs. Refer to table below for field specific information.</p>

Arkansas 1	NK 42T5XF	V5	Received 2.17" rain, Excellent growth, recommended 1 qt. Glufosinate 280L + 1 qt. Glyphosate + 3.25oz Zidua.
Arkansas 2	Pioneer P49Z02E	V1	Received 1.25", Almost V2. 119K plant population, field remains clean.
Clay	Pioneer P48Z70BLX	V2	Received 3.2" rain, bottom end still wet will replant soon, Recommended 1 qt. Glufosinate 280L + 1 qt. glyphosate + 1.25 pts S-metolachlor.

Jefferson	NK 43-W1XFS	V2	Received 3.26" rain, good growth, field remains clean, moderate deer feeding on the edge.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	VC	Planted Becks 4999XF at 130K treated seed on 5/10, emerged 5/17, stand counts next week, field remains clean.
Poinsett	Pioneer P48Z70BLX		Received .6" rain, Planted Pioneer P48Z70BLX at 125K treated seed on 5/19. Rain followed planting, expected to emerge before field dries, recommended 1 qt. Glufosinate 280L + 1 qt. Glyphosate + 1.25 pts s-metolachlor.

White	Pioneer P46A90LX	R2	Received 2.2" rain. Rapid growth, Early R2, remains clean, Low insect pressure.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG46XF3	R2	Received 3.2" rain. Excellent growth, Early R2, 4/25 Green Stinkbug, Tap root decline appear to have minor impact at this time.
