Herbicide applications have been delayed due to rain. Insect pressure remains low but starting to find a few Stinkbugs. Disease pressure is minor. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Cross	Asgrow AG47FX2	VC	Received 3” rain. soil is saturated, few still emerging, stand counts next week.
Drew	DynaGro S47XF23S	R2	Received 2.42” rain, Excellent growth, pulled tissue samples, recommended 1 qt. glyphosate(4lb) for grass control.
Jefferson	Delta Grow 48XF70STS	R2	Received 2.72” rain, pulled tissue samples, areas of the field has stunted growth, majority of field should have loose canopy next week.
Lawrence	Progeny 4515XFS	V5	Received 3.1” rain, good growth, waiting for field to dry for herbicide application, recommended 1 qt. liberty + 1 qt. glyphosate (4lb) + 1.25 pts s-metolachlor.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	V6	Received 4.38” rain will be R1 soon, good weed control.
Phillips	AgriGold G4910XF	V5	Received 3.1” rain, will be R1 soon, had water back out on field, several plants recovering, insect pressure remains low.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG47XF2	V2	Received 6.5” rain, excellent growth, will apply herbicide when field dries, Recommended 1 qt. liberty + 1 qt. glyphosate (4lb) + 3.25 oz Zidua.
Prairie			Will plant soon
White	Armor 48F55S	R3	Received 1.27” rain, Early R3, excellent growth, canopy next week. 1/25 brown/green stinkbugs.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG48XF3	V5	Received 2.07” rain, good growth, recommended 1 qt. liberty + 1. qt glyphosate(4lb) + 1.25 pts s-metolachlor. Possible tap root decline
