General

All fields received some rain this week with the least amount in Drew County with .4” and the most in Jackson County with 2.7”. Majority of fields are now in the reproductive stage and seeing excellent growth. Insect and disease pressure remains low. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Arkansas	Pioneer P45A40LX	R3	Received 2.4” rain, Initial irrigation 6/6.
Chicot	Asgrow AG46X6	R3	Received 1” rain. Initial irrigation 6/10.
Cross	Virtue 4520S	V5	Received 2.05”, Almost V6, good weed control, timely rain should see excellent growth.
Drew	Asgrow AG46X0	R2	Received .4” rain. Cleaned up, should take off.
Greene	Innvictis B4841E	V5	Received 1.2” rain, Good growth, Recommended 1 qt. Glyphosate + 2 pts. Enlist One + 1.25pts Dual II Magnum.
Jackson	Pioneer P48A14E	V3	Received 2.7” rain. Timely rain, applied 1 qt. glyphosate plus 2 pts. Enlist One 6/8. Good control.
Jefferson	Pioneer P46A36X	R3	Received .6” rain, Field remains clean.
Lawrence	Stine 46EE20	R3	Received 2.33, remains clean, should canopy next week, couple low spots stunted due to excess moisture.
Lonoke	Asgrow AG46F3	R1	Received .95” rain, Initial Irrigation 6/9.
Mississippi	Becks 4991X2	R3	Received .56” rain, remains clean, insect pressure remains low.
Poinsett			Will be planted behind wheat
Randolph	Pioneer P52A14SE	V5	Received .45” rain. Good weed control. Pivot irrigation 6/9.
St. Francis	Pioneer 46A20LX	R3	Received 1.4” rain, Loose canopy, remains clean, looks great.
White	Armor 46-E50	V4	Received 1” rain, applied 1 qt. glyphosate + 2 pts. Enlist One + 1.25pts Dual II Magnum, deer feeding seems to be slowing.
Yell	Pioneer P48A14E	V4	Received 1.1” rain, Almost V5, remains clean.
