General	By Chris Elkins. All fields received rainfall this week with Poinsett County receiving the most rain with 7.63” and Jefferson County with least with .51”. Several fields have started irrigation. Stinkbug pressure is starting to pick up but remains well below threshold. Frogeye Leaf Spot has been seen in a couple fields in very low levels. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Clay	Asgrow AG49XF4	R2	Received .91” rain, excellent growth, good canopy, low insect and disease pressure, initial irrigation scheduled for 6/28.
Cross	Asgrow AG47FX2	V6	Received 1.2 rain, good growth, replanted areas will be thin, recommended 1 qt. liberty + 1 qt. glyphosate(4lb) + 1 pt s-metolachlor.
Drew	DynaGro S47XF23S	R5	Received .72” rain, Early R5, Minor Frogeye Leaf Spot, initial irrigation 6/20. Second irrigation scheduled for 6/30
Jefferson	Delta Grow 48XF70STS	R5	Received .51” rain, Early R5, 1/25 Stinkbugs mixed, second irrigation scheduled for 6/29.
Lawrence	Progeny 4515XFS	R3	Received 2.72” rain, Almost R4, good canopy, insect and disease pressure remain low, Initial irrigation scheduled for 6/30.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	R3	Received 4.04” rain, Steady growth, late R3, initial irrigation scheduled for 6/30.
Phillips	AgriGold G4910XF	R4	Received 1.05” rain, Dryland, good moisture, good pod set, insect and disease pressure remains low.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG47XF2	R1	Received 7.63” rain, late R1, applied 12.8 oz. Engenia 6/19, followed by 1 qt. glyphosate + 1.25 pts s-metolachlor 6/20, insect and disease pressure low.
Prairie	UA54I19GT	V2	Received .32” rain, Almost V3, recommended 1 qt. glyphosate(4lb) + 2pts. Prefix, should continue to see good growth.
White	Armor 48F55S	R5	Received .79” rain, R5.2, 3/25 green stinkbugs, Downy Mildew common, Second irrigation scheduled for 6/30.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG48XF3	R2	Received .66” rain, excellent growth, remains clean, insect and disease pressure remain low, Initial irrigation scheduled for 6/24.
