Update No. 10

General

It is the time of year when rains become scattered, and irrigation is in full swing. Eleven fields received at least some rain with the most being in Lonoke County with 1.5". Cross, Greene, Mississippi and Randolph Counties received no rain. Insect and disease pressure remains low. Refer to table below for field specific information.

County	Variety	Stage	General Information
Arkansas	Pioneer P45A40LX	R5	Received .75" rain, clean, no disease or insect pressure.
Chicot	Asgrow AG46X6	R5	Received 1.3" rain. 1/25 brown stinkbugs, irrigated 6/27, looks really good.
Cross	Virtue 4520S	R2	No rain, excellent growth, initial irrigation soon, Insect and disease pressure remains low.
Drew	Asgrow AG46X0	R4	Received .8" rain. Initial irrigation should be soon. Insect and disease pressure remains low.
Greene	Innvictis B4841E	R1	No rain, Excellent growth, applied 1 qt. Glyphosate + 2 pts. Enlist One + 1.25pts Dual II Magnum 6/23, remains clean.
Jackson	Pioneer P48A14E	V6	Received .2" rain. Good growth, initial irrigation 6/28, Recommended 1 qt. glyphosate plus 2 pts Enlist One + 1.25 pts Dual II magnum, for grass and broadleaf control.
Jefferson	Pioneer P46A36X	R5	Received .72" rain, starting to pick up a few stinkbugs, initial irrigation scheduled for 6/30.
Lawrence	Stine 46EE20	R4	Received 1.15" rain, Early R4. remains clean, timely rain, insect pressure remains low, second irrigation scheduled for 7/1.
Lonoke	Asgrow AG46F3	R4	Received 1.5" rain, Excellent growth, no insect or disease pressure, should be irrigated soon.
Mississippi	Becks 4991X2	R4	No rain, applied 100lbs Muriate of Potash, second irrigation 6/27. Insect and disease pressure remains low.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG46XF3	VC	Received .7" rain, Stand counts next week, few more still emerging, good soil moisture.
Randolph	Pioneer P52A14SE	V9	No rain. Good canopy, insect and disease pressure remains low. Pivot irrigated 6/24 and 6/28, next irrigation scheduled for 7/1.
St. Francis	Pioneer 46A20LX	R4	Received .1" rain, second irrigation 6/26, good looking field, insect and disease pressure remains low.
White	Armor 46-E50	R1	Received .16" rain, good growth, remains clean, initial irrigation scheduled for 7/1.
Yell	Pioneer P48A14E	R1	Received .9" rain, recommended 1 qt. glyphosate, insect pressure remains low, initial irrigation scheduled for 7/5.
