

General	By Chris Elkins. All fields received rainfall. Jefferson county received the most rain with 1.43” and Mississippi county received the least with .1”. Herbicide applications should resume toward the end of the week. Low levels of Stinkbug and defoliation feeders are common. Disease pressure is minor. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Clay	Asgrow AG49XF4	V5	Received .88” rain, Excellent growth, grass and broadleaf pressure picking up, recommended 1 qt. liberty + 1 qt. glyphosate (4lb) + 1.25 pts. s-metolachlor.
Cross	Asgrow AG47FX2	V1	Received .61” rain. 112K plant stand count, field has a couple areas where deer feeding and excess moisture may require replant
Drew	DynaGro S47XF23S	R2	Received .82” rain, continues to have excellent growth, should canopy next week.
Jefferson	Delta Grow 48XF70STS	R3	Received 1.43” rain, Early R3, 1.5/25 Stinkbugs mixed.
Lawrence	Progeny 4515XFS	V6	Received .15” rain, will be R1 next week, field slow to dry, recommended 1 qt. liberty + 1 qt. glyphosate (4lb) + 1.25 pts s-metolachlor.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	R2	Received .1” rain, Early R2, pulled tissue samples, insect pressure remains low, possible tap root decline.
Phillips	AgriGold G4910XF	R1	Received .8” rain, good growth, insect and disease pressure remains low. Majority of flooded beans recovered.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG47XF2	V3	Received .45” rain, good growth, will apply herbicide when field dries, Recommended 1 qt. liberty + 1 qt. glyphosate (4lb) + 3.25 oz Zidua. Will require sequential program for control.
Prairie	UA54I19GT		Good field condition, planting expected to take place this week.
White	Armor 48F55S	R3	Received .44” rain, late R3, good canopy. 1/25 brown/green stinkbugs. Initial irrigation scheduled for 6/10.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG48XF3	V6	Received .97” rain, R1 next week, will apply 1 qt. liberty + 1. qt glyphosate(4lb) + 1.25 pts s-metolachlor. 1.5/25 stinkbugs mixed, light defoliation pressure.
