Craighead County received the most rain with 2.35" and Prairie County and Arkansas County 1 received no rain. Stinkbug numbers continue to climb and Corn earworms are showing up in several fields. Disease pressure has slowed over the last week. Refer to table below for field specific information.</p>

Arkansas 1	NK 42T5XF	R5	No rain, 2.5/25 green stinkbugs, Mid R5, Filling pods quickly, Frogeye and bacterial blight slightly increased. Second irrigation scheduled for 7/18.
Arkansas 2	Pioneer P49Z02E	R4	Received .12" rain, Almost R5, 2.5/25 corn earworms and minor Frogeye. Initial irrigation 7/16.
Clay	Pioneer P48Z70BLX	R3	Received .85" rain, 2/25 green stinkbugs, disease pressure remains low, second irrigation scheduled for 7/18.
Craighead	Asgrow AG47FX2	R2	Received 2.35" rain. Almost R2, excellent growth. initial irrigation scheduled for 7/25.
Jefferson	NK 43-W1XFS	R5	Received .1" rain, RKN damage has expanded, 1/25 Corn earworm, Early R5, Second Irrigation 7/16, Next irrigation is scheduled for 7/24.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	R3	Received .34" rain. Almost R4, Insect and disease pressure remain low, Initial irrigation 7/10. Second Irrigation 7/17.
Poinsett	Pioneer P48Z70BLX	R2	Received .6" rain, Excellent growth, 80-90% canopy. Insect and Disease pressure low. Second irrigation scheduled for 7/17.
Prairie	Pioneer P48A14E	V2	No rain. Almost V3, should continue to see rapid growth. Good control of broadleaves, grass control slow.
White	Pioneer P46A90LX	R6	Received 1.35" rain. Good pod fill, 5.3/25 stinkbugs, Next irrigation scheduled for 7/23
Woodruff	Asgrow AG46XF3	R5	Received .31" rain. Late R5. 1/25 green stinkbugs, Third irrigation 7/15.
