<b>General</b>	<p>By Chris Elkins.</p> <p>Rain was limited and irrigation continued to be the focus. Mississippi County received the most rain with .33" and seven counties received no rain. Stinkbug and corn earworm numbers remain steady. Soybean looper numbers are low but picking up in southern fields. Frogeye has picked up slowly in a couple fields. Refer to table below for field specific information.</p>

Arkansas 1	NK 42T5XF	R5	No rain, Late R5, 3/25 stinkbugs. Second irrigation 7/22, Third irrigation scheduled for 7/31.
Arkansas 2	Pioneer P49Z02E	R5	No rain, Good pod set, 3.5/25 corn earworms and light Frogeye pressure. Second irrigation 7/25.
Clay	Pioneer P48Z70BLX	R4	No rain, Insect and disease pressure remains low, second irrigation 7/18, Third irrigation scheduled for 7/27.
Craighead	Asgrow AG47FX2	R2	Received .2" rain. Excellent growth, should canopy next week, initial irrigation scheduled for 7/25.
Jefferson	NK 43-W1XFS	R5	No rain, Early R5, insect pressure remains low, low foliar disease, Third Irrigation 7/24, Next irrigation is scheduled for 8/1.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	R4	Received .33" rain. Early R4, Insect and disease pressure remain low, Excellent growth, third irrigation scheduled for 7/22.
Poinsett	Pioneer P48Z70BLX	R2	Received .08" rain, Good Canopy. Insect and Disease pressure low. Second irrigation 7/17, Third Irrigation scheduled for 7/24.
Prairie	Pioneer P48A14E	V4	No rain. Excellent growth. Recommended 1 qt. glyphosate for grass control. Initial Irrigation scheduled for 7/31.
White	Pioneer P46A90LX	R6	No rain. Quickly finishing up, 4/25 stinkbugs, Irrigation 7/23, Final irrigation if needed 7/30.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG46XF3	R6	No rain. Quickly filling pods. 1/25 green stinkbugs, Fourth irrigation 7/22. Fifth and possible final irrigation 7/30.
