Update No. 17

General

Rain was scattered across the Verification fields with two fields receiving over 3". Insect pressure has dropped over the past week. Disease pressure picked up in a few fields with Jackson County requiring treatment. Six fields are now done and waiting on harvest. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Greene	Innvictis B4841E	R5	Received .85", slight lodging, third irrigation scheduled for 8/21.
Jackson	Pioneer P48A14E	R5	Received .15" rain, aerial web blight scattered across field, recommended 13.7 oz Miravis top. Next irrigation scheduled for 8/20.
Jefferson	Pioneer P46A36X	R6	Done. Waiting on harvest.
Lawrence	Stine 46EE20	R6	Received 2.7" rain, Done. Waiting on Harvest.
Lonoke	Asgrow AG46F3	R5	Received .5" rain. Very close to R6, Insect and disease pressure remains low, Irrigation 8/14.
Mississippi	Becks 4991X2	R6	Received 1" rain. Done Waiting on harvest.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG46XF3	R3	Received 4.05" rain, Almost R4, insect pressure remains low, Next irrigation scheduled for 8/21.
Randolph	Pioneer P52A14SE	R5	Received .75" rain. Insect pressure remains low, good pod set, next irrigation scheduled for 8/20.
St. Francis	Pioneer 46A20LX	R7	Done. Waiting on Harvest.
White	Armor 46-E50	R5	Received .1", insect and disease pressure remain low. Next irrigation 8/17.
Yell	Pioneer P48A14E	R5	Received 1.6" rain, insect pressure remain low, initial irrigation scheduled for 8/19.
