Update No. 15

General

Rain was limited this week. Yell County received the most rain with .9” and eight fields received no rain. Several early planted fields are receiving final irrigation. Insect pressure picked back up and Chicot County reached threshold. Disease pressure has also picked up this past week. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Arkansas	Pioneer P45A40LX	R6	No rain, last irrigation 7/31, remains clean.
Chicot	Asgrow AG46X6	R6	No rain. Red banded Stinkbugs reached threshold, applied 6.4 oz bifenthrin + .5 lbs acephate 8/2, Irrigated 8/1 should be final irrigation.
Cross	Virtue 4520S	R5	No rain, Early R5, initial irrigation 8/1.
Drew	Asgrow AG46X0	R5	No rain, Irrigation 7/25, remains clean.
Greene	Innvictis B4841E	R4	Received .1”, Almost R5, minor disease pressure, second irrigation 8/3.
Jackson	Pioneer P48A14E	R3	Received .1” rain. Late R3, 1/100 corn earworms, irrigation 8/2.
Jefferson	Pioneer P46A36X	R6	No rain, last irrigation 7/31, remains clean.
Lawrence	Stine 46EE20	R5	No rain, very close to R6, insect pressure remains low, third irrigation 8/1.
Lonoke	Asgrow AG46F3	R5	No rain. Insect and disease pressure remains low, irrigation 7/31.
Mississippi	Becks 4991X2	R5	Received .1” rain, irrigated 7/30, slow to reach R6, remains clean.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG46XF3	R2	Received .8” rain, rapid growth, initial irrigation soon.
Randolph	Pioneer P52A14SE	R3	Received .75” rain. Frogeye started to pick up, applied 13.7 oz Miravis Top 7/31, Pivot irrigated 7/27 & 7/30.
St. Francis	Pioneer 46A20LX	R6	No rain, 3/25 stinkbugs, irrigated 7/25, Final irrigation scheduled for 8/4.
White	Armor 46-E50	R4	Received .50”, 1/50 stinkbugs, deer feeding area finally canopied. Next irrigation 8/5.
Yell	Pioneer P48A14E	R4	Received .9” rain, Still putting on new growth, initial irrigation scheduled for 8/8.
