General	<p>By Chris Elkins.</p> <p>Fields are wrapping up quickly and harvest is expected to start next week. Mississippi County received the most rain with .58" and Poinsett County field received the least with .21". Seven fields are now done and waiting for harvest. Disease and insect pressure are currently not an issue for late planted fields. Refer to table below for field specific information.</p>

Prairie	Pioneer P48A14E	R5*	Received .41" rain, Early R5, Excellent pod set for size. insect and disease pressure remain low, next irrigation scheduled for 9/10. *previous week was R4, not the R2 listed.

Woodruff	Asgrow AG46XF3	R8	Done, waiting on harvest. Expected harvest next week.
