General Information

The fields that have been harvested include Clark, Cross, Jefferson, Pulaski and White Counties. Those fields remaining include Drew, Phillips, Mississippi and Woodruff Counties. Yields have been fair to good except for Clark County. White County has the best yield so far with 236 bu/ac.

Drew	RT 7521 FP (Row Rice)	Mature	Ready for Harvest.

Pulaski	RT 7521 FP* (Zero Grade)	Harvested 8/26	187 bu/ac average moisture 18%
Mississippi	RT 7321 FP* (Row Rice)	Mature	Ready for Harvest.
White	RT 7321 FP*	Harvested 9/4	236 bu/ac moisture 18.1%
Woodruff	DG 263 L ⁺	Mature	Ready for Harvest.
