General	There are 16 Demo fields within the CRVSP in 2021. Some of the earliest planted fields of cotton, had to be replanted as cooler than normal temperatures are believed to have impacted emergence and growth. Some areas also received some hard packing rains. Many of the fields have either just been planted or will be planted soon.

Cotton was replanted on 5/15, and during field visit on 5/19 very few new plants had emerged, but when digging down to look at the seed the radicle was popping on all seeds that I looked at that day.
