General Information

Fields at 2/3 straw-colored kernels and draining include Cross, Jefferson, Lonoke and White Counties. Fields at the 100 % heading stage include Drew, Mississippi, and Woodruff Counties. Chicot and Poinsett County are at the early heading stage. Woodruff County has exceeded the threshold level for stink bugs. The Jefferson and White County fields should cut a sample next week.

Chicot	CLL18 (FIR)	Early Heading	50% Heading 8/9.
Drew	RT 7521 FP (FIR)	100% Headed	Stink bugs average 1 per 10 sweeps. Rainfall .34"
Jefferson	Ozark	2/3 Straw-colored kernels	Field is draining. 20% grain moisture 8/14.
Lonoke	RT 7521 FP*	2/3 Straw-colored Kernels	Field is draining. 20% grain moisture 8/19.
Mississippi	RT 7321 FP* (FIR)	100% Headed	Stink bugs average 3 per 10 sweeps.
Poinsett	Ozark	Early Heading	Disease has been below threshold. 50% heading 8/14.
White	RT 7521 FP*	2/3 Straw-colored Kernels	Field is draining. 20% grain moisture 8/17.
Woodruff	RT 7521 FP*	100% Headed	Stink bugs average 12.5 per 10 sweeps. Recommended Tenchu 20 SG 8 oz + 1 % COC.
