General Information

Fields that have been harvested or partially harvested include Drew and Monroe counties. Bill bug damage to row-rice fields was prevalent on upper ends. Phillips county should be harvested by this weekend weather permitting. Fields at 100% hard dough and draining include Crittenden, Jefferson, Lonoke and Mississippi Counties. St Francis is at 60% hard dough and water turned off.
