General Information

All fields again got in on the rainfall over this past week ranging from .35” at Lee to 4” at Drew. Southern fields have exhibited very rapid growth this week and are off and running. Soil applied residuals have worked great this year, as you would expect, due to timely rainfall. Refer to the table below for field-specific information.

Arkansas	Pioneer P48A60X	R1	Received 2.34” rain. Tremendous growth over the past week. Looks good.
Chicot	Asgrow AG46X6	R2	Received .6” rain. Didn’t get sprayed again this past week, will evaluate again next week. Another field with big growth.
Conway	Local Seed ZS4694ES3	V3	1.00” rain, Continues to have good growth, unable to apply herbicide last week, Recommended 22oz Round up PowerMax III plus 2pts Enlist one + 1.25 pts S-metolachlor

Desha	Asgrow AG48XF2	R1	Received 1.4” rain. Sprayed 6-7 with 1 qt. Cornerstone + 1 qt. Prefix. Clean and growing rapidly.
Drew	Armor 46D-09	R1	Couldn’t get to rain gauge due to high water but looked like at least 4”. Cleaned up from last week spray and rapidly growing.
Greene	NK-H3XFS	V2	2.75” rain, Heavy rains caused some damage, furrows still have standing water, should recover quickly, good weed control.
Independence	NK S46E3S	V6	.2” rain, Dryland, Expect to see a few blooms next week, Defoliation has slowed and continues to average around 15%, no newly emerged weeds.

Lawrence			Planted 6/7/2022, Recommended 1 qt. Glyphosate + 1.25pts S-metolachlor. Barnyard and Weedy rice present.
Lee	Mission 4690XF	R1	Received .35” rain. Looks as though the herbicide may have worked, will know more next week.
Lonoke	Asgrow AG46X6	V4	Received 2.3” rain. Some grass and morningglories. Recommended glyphosate + 3.2 oz. Zidua SC.
Mississippi	Becks 5005XF	V1	3.05” rain, Almost V2, Stand count 101K plants per acre, several areas remain saturated and could impact stand.
Monroe	Progeny 4604XF	V6	Received 1.1” rain. Sprayed 36 oz Liberty + 1.2 pt. s-metolachlor 6-4.
Poinsett	Becks 4885XF	V4	.55” rain, Excellent growth, Morning glories and light grass pressure, recommended 1 qt. Liberty plus 12 oz. Outlook.

St. Francis	Dyna-Gro 48XT56	V2	1" rain, Almost V3, remains clean, moderate deer feeding in one corner, more rain on the way.
White	NK42TSXT	V2	1.05" rain, Good growth, grass and broadleaf pressure increased, recommended 1 qt. Liberty plus 3.25oz Anthem Maxx.
