

## 2018-19 Wheat Research Verification Program Fall Update



## **December 14, 2018**

Update No. 1

General	By Chad Norton and Chris Elkins. The 2018-19 wheat season is off to a slow, wet start. Fall rains delayed harvest of several acres of double crop soybeans and continued rains did not allow opportunity for fields to be planted. The fields planted in the WRVP were planted in late October and have had slow growth. Plant stands are adequate and fields are in good condition overall as we head into winter months.		
County	Variety	Feekes Stage	General Information
Ashley	Pioneer 26R41	1.3	Planted 10/22/2018, emerged 10/29 to a plant stand of 23 plants per sq. ft.
Greene	Pioneer 26R41	2.2	Planted 10/19/2018 @ 120lbs/acre, 1" depth on 10" rows. Emerged 11/2 to a plant stand of 26 plants per sq. ft. Weed pressure remains low, small area of flood damage. Overall field looks good going into winter.
Lee	Pioneer 26R41	1.3	Planted 10/30/2018, emerged 11/7 to a plant stand of 18 plants per sq. ft.
