County	Variety	Feekes Stage	General Information
			Cold front expected to move in next week and keep growth slow. When favorable weather condition allow spring nitrogen application will start to go out. So far fields have had good drainage. Disease and insect pressure not present at this time.
Arkansas	Pioneer P26R41	3	Looks good. Field drains very well. Will be considering N application after forecasted deep freeze next week.
Ashley	AGS 2055	3	Looking very good. Well drained field. Spring N application as soon as weather warms a little.
Chicot	Pioneer P26R45	3	Looks good. Some moisture stress in bottom of middles. Spring N application after weather warms.
Clay	Dixie Bentley	3	Good growth, drainage is fair with several small areas of excess moisture. Will look to make first spring N application soon.
Jefferson	Local Seed LW 2848	2	Looks good. Somewhat slower growth than other fields. Some P deficiency symptoms in few areas. Need warmer weather.
Lawrence	Delta Grow 1000	3	Slowed growth, excellent drainage, field has lost deep green color and looking rough with slower growth, expected to bounce back quickly when growing temps increase and spring N is applied.
Lee	Local Seed LW 2848	3	Broadcast planted 10-21-20 at 100 lbs/acre. 2 oz/acre Zidua applied for weed control. More information soon.
