County	Variety	Feekes Stage	General Information The weather has finally started to dry out and temperatures are picking up. We should continue to see good growing condition over the upcoming week. Fields have started to green up and spring N applications are being applied. No insect or disease pressure at this time.
Arkansas	Pioneer P26R41	3	Heavy deer pressure, thinned the stand a little. Applied 100# DAP + 50# ammonium sulfate + 100 urea 3-8. Second N application in couple weeks.
Ashley	AGS 2055	5	Very good looking field. Applied 100# DAP + 50# ammonium sulfate + 100# urea 2-8 and 130# urea 3-10.
Chicot	Pioneer P26R45	4	Starting to perk up. Applied 50# ammonium sulfate + 120# urea 3-11. Second N application in couple weeks.
Clay	Dixie Bentley	3	Growth has remained slow, field has dried up, Will apply 50 AMS and 50lbs Urea 3/5. Second application of 100lbs Urea schedule for next week.
Jefferson	Local Seed LW 2848	3	Greening up very well. Applied .9 oz. Harmony Extra for weeds. 100# urea + 100# MEZ applied 2-3 and 50# ammonium sulfate + 50# MEZ + 120# urea applied 3-8.
Lawrence	Delta Grow 1000	3	Field has really greened up, growth remains slow, First application of spring N applied 2/26 of 50lbs AMS and 50 lbs urea. Recommend 100lbs Urea.
Lee	Local Seed LW 2848	4	Came through the winter well. Applied 75# DAP + 75# ammonium sulfate 1-25 and 130# urea 3-10. Last of N will be applied in couple weeks. Recommended .9 oz. Harmony Extra for weeds.
