Clay	Dixie Bentley	8	Excellent growth, good weed control. Disease remains low in canopy.
Jefferson	Local Seed LW 2848	10	Should start heading next week. Looks good.
Lawrence	Delta Grow 1000	8	Continues to look good, Flag leaf starting to emerge. Disease remains low in canopy.
Lee	Local Seed LW 2848	10	Should start heading next week.
