**Update No. 1**

<b>General</b>	By Chad Norton and Chris Elkins. The 2019-2020 wheat production season is underway. Late planted spring crops have delayed harvest in several areas which has resulted in a tight planting window for wheat producers. Rains have started to pick up keeping several areas too wet to plant and has reduced stands in areas. Early planted fields are off to a good start and several fields should start tillering soon. However, growth is starting to slow with an early season cold front moving across the state. Hopefully we can get a few more weeks of warm, dry weather before we go into the winter months.

Lawrence	Dixie Brown	1.2	Pre-plant fertilizer 10-40-40 applied. Drill planted on 10/18/19. Emerged 10/28/219 to a plant population of 17 plants plants/ft <sup>2</sup> . Rains following planting hurt emergence and spot planting of 2-3 acres will be needed.
