



Arkansas Rice Research Verification Program Weekly Update June 6, 2025 – Update No. 8

General Information

More fields are getting permanent floods established just prior to the final recommended time. Fields with permanent floods established include Chicot, Jefferson, Lonoke, Prairie and White Counties. Several fields are at the 4^{th} tiller stage and soon to be at the panicle initiation (PI) stage. Those fields include Chicot, Lonoke, Prairie and White Counties. The Desha County (FIR) field got its 3^{rd} fertilizer application and is at the $\frac{1}{2}$ " (IE) stage. The Poinsett County field is at the 2^{nd} tiller stage while Woodruff County is approaching the 3-leaf stage.

Lonoke	RT 7521 FP*	4 th Tiller	The field is clean and uniform with good flood. Panicle initiation (PI) starts 6/8 according to DD-50.
Prairie	RT 7302	4 th Tiller	Applied Duet (4 qts) + Permit (.25 oz) + COC (1 %) N-STaR Urea (260 lbs) + NBPT applied 5/27 Good flood is established.
Poinsett	CLL18 (FIR)	2 nd Tiller	Newpath (6 oz) + Prowl (2.1 pts) applied 6/2 Urea (250 lbs) + NBPT went out 6/3
White	RT 7521 FP*	4 th Tiller	Preface (5 oz) + NIS (.25%) applied 5/29 N-STaR Urea (300 lbs) + NBPT applied 5/30 water is on.
Woodruff	RT 7421 FP*	3-leaf	The field finally got dry enough from flood rains. Straight levees are up and planted. Will need a flush if doesn't rain soon. Command (12.8 oz) + Sharpen (2 oz) + Glyphosate (32 oz) residual herbicides still holding.
