General	By Chris Elkins. Rainfall continued to be limited with White County receiving the most rain with .85" and three fields received no rain. Several fields are starting to fill pods. Stinkbug pressure reached threshold in White County but remains low across the state. Disease pressure remains low; Frogeye Leaf Spot is common. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Cross	Asgrow AG47FX2	R2	Received .57" rain, Excellent growth, loose Canopy, Initial irrigation scheduled for 7/13.
Drew	DynaGro S47XF23S	R5	Received .62" rain, R5.5, minor frogeye, insects remain low, irrigation scheduled for 7/16.
Jefferson	Delta Grow 48XF70STS	R5	Received .4" rain, R5.5, 2/25 Stinkbugs mixed, light frogeye, third irrigation scheduled for 7/13.
Lawrence	Progeny 4515XFS	R4	No rain, good pod set, insect and disease pressure remain low, second irrigation scheduled for 7/10.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	R4	No rain, late R4, insect and disease pressure remain low, initial irrigation 7/4, second irrigation scheduled for 7/11.
Phillips	AgriGold G4910XF	R5	Received .53" rain, Dryland, R5.2, good pod set, slightly dry, insect and disease pressure remains low.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG47XF2	R2	Received .76", excellent growth, will canopy soon, 1/50 stinkbugs, initial irrigation 7/4.
Prairie	UA54I19GT	V6	Received .4", good growth, good weed control, should see rapid growth, Initial irrigation scheduled for 7/13.
White	Aarmor 48F55S	R5	Received .85, R5.8, green stinkbugs reached threshold applied 1.92 oz Lambda cyhalothrin on 7/7, low disease pressure, Third irrigation scheduled for 7/14.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG48XF3	R4	Received .18" rain, setting pods quickly, insect and disease pressure remain low, second irrigation scheduled for 7/13.
