General	By Chris Elkins. Hot and dry weather continued this week. Woodruff County received the most rain with .54" and four fields received no rain. Stinkbug and loopers pressure have increased but remain below threshold. Fields are wrapping up quickly and harvest is expected to start in a couple of weeks.
