September 2022 USDA Supply/Demand Summary



Corn: Projected beginning stocks for 2022/23 are 5 million bushels lower. Corn production for 2022/23 is forecast at 13.9 billion bushels, down 415 million from last month on reductions to harvested area and yield. The national average yield is forecast at 172.5 bushels per acre, down 2.9 bushels. Harvested area for grain is forecast at 80.8 million acres, down 1.0 million. Total U.S. corn use is cut 250 million bushels to 14.3 billion. Feed and residual use is lowered 100 million bushels based on a smaller crop and higher expected prices. Exports are cut 100 million bushels to 2.3 billion while corn used for ethanol is lowered 50 million to 5.3 billion. With supply falling more than use, ending stocks are down 169 million bushels to 1.2 billion. The season-average corn price received by producers is raised 10 cents to \$6.75 per bushel.

Soybeans: New crop soybean production is projected at 4.4 billion bushels, down 152 million on lower harvested area and yield. Harvested area is down 0.6 million from the August forecast. The soybean yield forecast of 50.5 bushels per acre is down 1.4 bushels from last month. The crush forecast is reduced 20 million bushels and the soybean export forecast is reduced 70 million bushels on lower supplies. Ending stocks are projected at 200 million bushels, down 45 million from last month. The U.S. season-average soybean price is forecast at \$14.35 per bushel, unchanged from last month. The season average soybean meal price was unchanged at \$390 per short ton.

Long-Grain Rice: Long-grain supplies are reduced on a combination of lower beginning stocks and smaller production. Beginning stocks are lowered .8 million cwt. on data from the NASS Rice Stocks report, issued August 19. The NASS September Crop Production report reduced 2022/23 production by 8 million cwt to 132.3 million on decreased harvested area and lower yields. The average long-grain yield is down 30 pounds per acre to 7,441 pounds. Domestic and residual use was lowered by 3.0 million cwt to 112.0 million on the smaller crop size. Exports were lowered 2.0 million cwt to 58.0 million as U.S. rice is expected to be increasingly uncompetitive with lower supplies. Ending stocks were decreased by 2.8 million cwt to 20.9 million, down 15 percent from last year. The season-average farm price for long-grain was raised \$0.50 per cwt to a record \$16.50.

Cotton: The 2022/23 U.S. cotton beginning stocks were increased 250,000 bales. Production was 1.3 million bales higher this month at 13.8 million, with higher production expected in most major producing states. Exports are projected 600,000 bales higher at 12.6 million this month as the U.S. share of exportable supplies rises, and ending stocks are 900,000 bales higher at 2.7 million bales. The season-average price for upland cotton is forecast at 96 cents per pound, 1 cent lower than in August.

World production is projected 1.4 million bales higher this month at 118.45 million on production increases in the United States, Australia, China, and Turkey. World ending stocks are 2.0 million bales higher this month, at 84.75 million bales, near unchanged from 21/22.
