

APPLE NAME ACTIVITY



MATERIALS:

- Red felt
- Green felt or ribbon
- 3 plastic beads
- Sharp scissors
- Permanent marker



Cut out apple shapes from the red felt. You will need as many apples as there are letters in the child's name. Cut small slits (big enough for the letters to be written on, in between the slits, and string to go through).



Tie a knot at the end of the green felt or ribbon and slip 3 beads onto it (this will be the side that is strung through the apples). On the opposite side of the felt string tie a knot as well. This helps the felt/ribbon be sturdier for when the child is threading.



Label the apples with individual letters to spell the child's name.



The child will thread the side of the green felt that has the beads through the slits that you had previously cut in the apple.



This is the final product! *For younger children you can make only one hole in the 'apple' for them to string the thread through.
