



AEHC Scholarship Criteria for Two \$1000 Scholarships

Dr. Lynn Russell Memorial AEHC Scholarship **Betty F. Oliver Memorial Scholarship**

The criteria for the Arkansas Extension Homemakers Council Scholarships of \$1000 each is as follows:

1. Each scholarship will be awarded to a college student majoring in Family and Consumer Sciences/Human Environmental Sciences. Student must be enrolled in an Arkansas college or university.
2. The student must have a minimum of 59 credit hours at the beginning of the subsequent semester.
3. The student must have a cumulative grade point of 2.5 or higher.
4. Preference will be given to an Arkansas high school graduate or native Arkansan.
5. The final decision will be made by the three Arkansas Extension Homemakers Council District Directors from the nominees submitted.
6. The scholarships will be awarded at the AEHC State Conference during the first week in June. It is the desire of AEHC that the student, accompanied by one guest, attend the Award Luncheon to personally receive the scholarship.
7. Funds from the scholarships are written to the student's school, after student has confirmed they are enrolled for the next semester.
8. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
