

DO NOT DISTURB MOUND PRIOR TO TREATMENT

- Step 1 Broadcast application of bait product.
- Step 2 Mound treatment of individual nuisance or problem mounds (use bait or contact insecticide). Apply Step 2 one week AFTER applying Step 1.

Are conditions right to treat Fire Ants?

- Temperature between 70° and 90°F
 No rain expected within 12 hours
 Ants actively foraging (check with hot dog
- pieces)
