Why use groundcovers?

- Hard to grow grass—
too much shade
- Steep slope
- Rocky soil or exposed
roots
- Living mulch
- Don't want to mow!

Scotch Moss – *Sagina subulata*

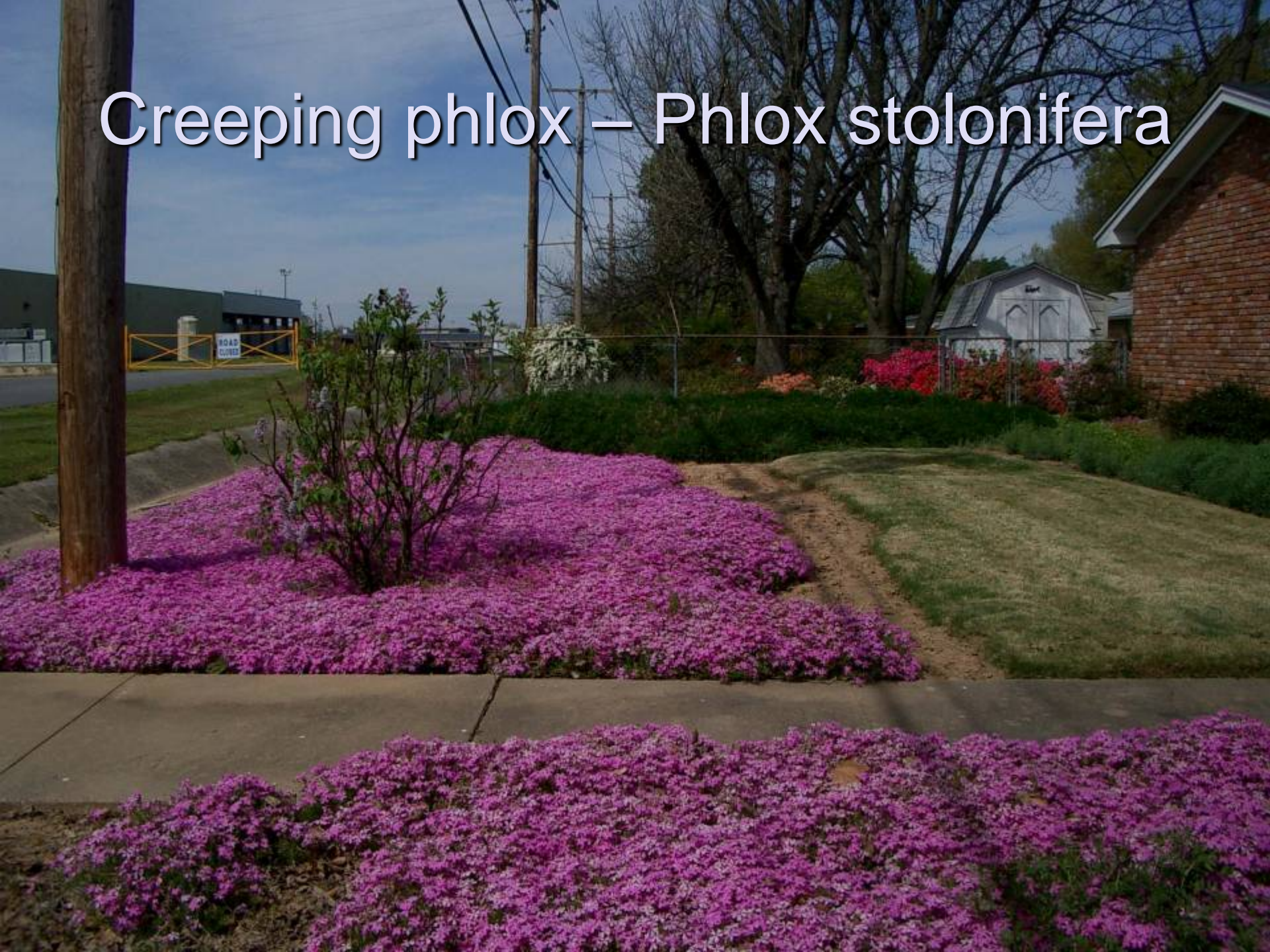


In hot, humid summer this sometimes melts out and becomes unattractive in mid summer.

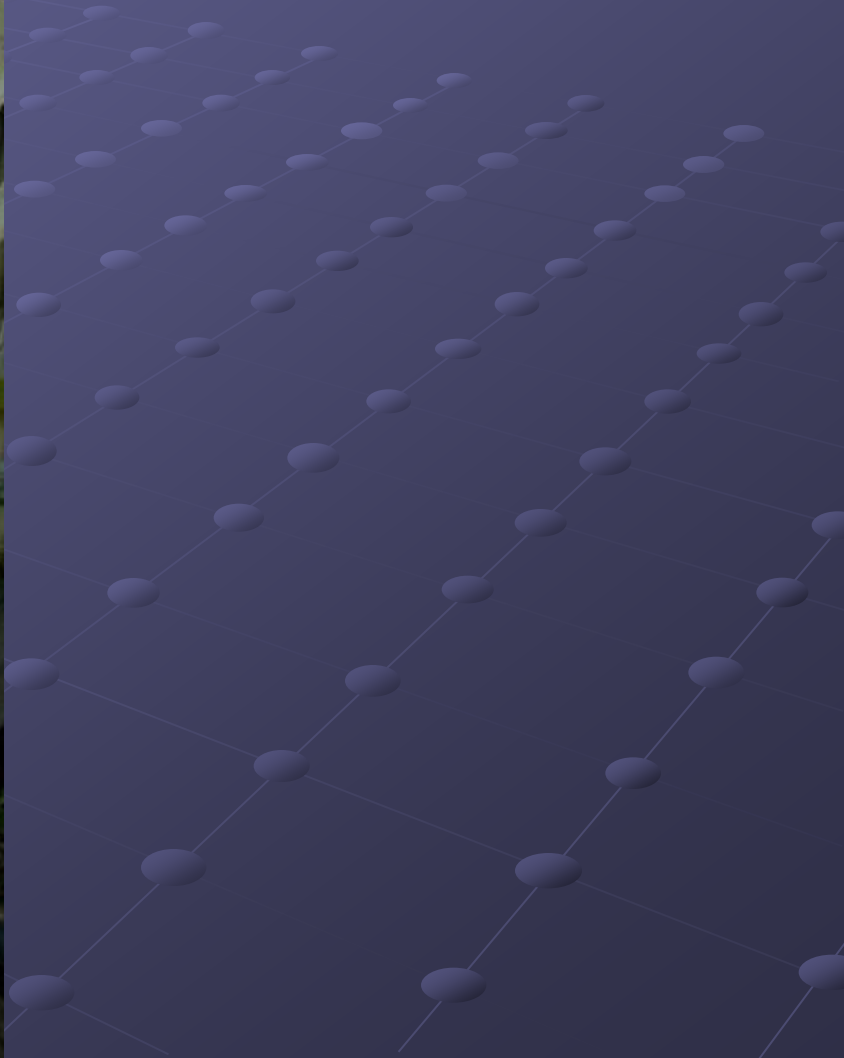

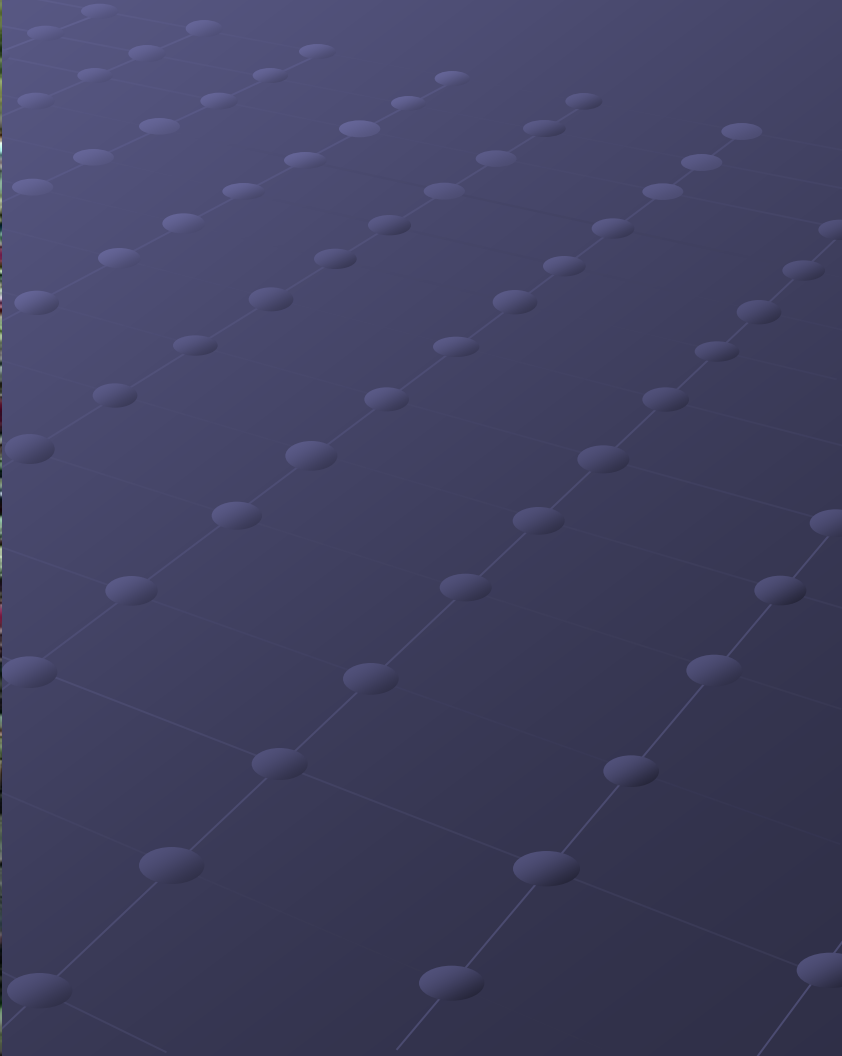
