Ornamental Grasses by Common Name

Common Name	Scientific Name	Comments
Blue Fescue	Festuca ovina 'Glauca'	 Small (8 to 10"), clump forming grass Full sun Selections for improved blue color; 'Elijah Blue', 'Boulder Blue' May also be listed as Festuca cinerea
Fountaingrass	Pennisetum alopecuroides	 Low (18 to 24"), clump forming grass Cultivars: 'Hameln', 'Moudry'
Japanese Bloodgrass	Imperata cylindrica 'Red Baron'	 Size: 15 to 18" Leaves red in full sun Spreads by rhizomes to form patch
Maiden Grass	Miscanthus sinensis	Medium sized (4 to 5'), clump forming grass Cultivars: 'Gracillimus', 'Zebrinus', 'Strictus'
Ornamental Sedge	Carex sp.	 Usually a low (12"), clump forming grass Many species and cultivars (mainly for variegated leaves) Full sun

Pampas Grass	Cortaderia selloana	 Large (10'), clump forming grass Full sun Dramatic plumes Invasive in western U.S.
